RESIDENCY SUMMARY

The Chautauqua School of Art Residency Program is a distinctive 7-week visual arts program in Chautauqua, NY. As part of the more extensive Chautauqua Visual Arts experience, attending artists have access to ample studio space, a summer lecture series, performances, technical classes, and professional development opportunities. Other program benefits include a robust alumni program, establishing avenues for selling your work, making connections with institutional partners, ongoing relationships, and more.

Participant Selection: Each year, approximately thirty-eight participants join the program. All eligible artists are considered with no preference to racial or ethnic origins, gender, sexual orientation, religious affiliation, disability, or age. As a result, selected participants become an intergenerational cohort, with each member bringing value to the group through their diversity of backgrounds and experiences.

The Program & Facilities: The program is composed of workshops and one-on-one time with mentors in all media. The curriculum intentionally breaks apart the traditional methods that silo disciplines from each other and instead embraces a full range of studio and pragmatic studies. Facilities at the School of Art include a fully-equipped ceramic facility, printmaking studio, digital media studio, drawing room, outdoor sculpture facility with welding equipment, and plenty of outdoor space to make work, experiment, and host pop-up events.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

If accepted into the residency program:

- A minimum of \$500 will be applied toward residency tuition and fees.
- · Additional funding and tuition waivers are available through Chautauqua.
