- Undergraduate Junior or Senior, Department of Art & Design Major
- Graduate Student in the Department of Art & Design

ETSU PARTNERSHIP

ETSU Department of Art & Design is in partnership with Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts to support student growth outside the university through the Windgate University Fellows Scholarship Fund.

SELECTION

A selection committee appointed by the Chair of the Department of Art & Design will award scholarships. Selection will be based on the quality of the combination of submitted materials. Preference will be given to undergraduate students. If the undergraduate applicant pool is found to be unsatisfactory, the Arrowmont Scholarship may be awarded to a graduate student.

DESCRIPTION

Provides one full scholarship to attend a one-week summer class of your choice at Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts. Arrowmont is located in Gatlinburg, TN. Students should not apply if they anticipate having difficulty attending an immersive one-week summer session on Arrowmont's campus. Course selection will take place in January.

REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION

- Completed Art & Design Scholarship Application.
- Submit a 2-paragraph essay on why you want to take a class at Arrowmont this summer.
- Name and office phone number of an Art & Design faculty member who will offer a verbal reference for this application.
- 10 Digital artwork images.
- Unofficial transcript.
