

Windgate-Lamar Fellowship Nomination

CRITERIA

- Undergraduate Senior *
- Art & Design Major working in craft media

ETSU PARTNERSHIP

ETSU Department of Art & Design is in partnership with the Center for Craft in Asheville, North Carolina to support student growth outside the university.

FELLOWSHIP INFORMATION

ETSU is one of over 100 Colleges and Universities across the United States that participate in the Windgate Lamar Fellowship program. The purpose of this externally funded fellowship is to advance the careers of emerging craft artists post-graduation. Each year participating universities may select up to two undergraduate seniors whose work is exemplary and related to, or informed by, craft processes, materials, traditions, and/or sensibilities. Selected nominees will have the opportunity to apply for the Windgate-Lamar Fellowship. If selected, nominees will develop and submit a proposal for a \$15,000 fellowship award under the advisement of a designated faculty mentor. Ten Windgate-Lamar Fellowship awards are granted through the Center for Craft annually.

SELECTION

A selection committee comprised of the ceramics, fibers, and metals area faculty members will review and rank applications from senior students working in craft media. Ranking will be based upon the criteria used in the Windgate-Lamar Fellowship application. The selection committee will put the top two ranking applications forth in nomination. If the pool of applicants in a given year is minimal, or does not meet the standards of the Windgate-Lamar Fellowship application, the selection committee may reduce the number of nominations to 1 or 0.

REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION TO REQUEST NOMINATION

- Completed Windgate-Lamar Application Form
- 10 digital artwork images**
- Artist Statement (250 word)

SUBMISSION OF MATERIALS: OneDrive

DEADLINE: November 1

* Nominees for the upcoming year must graduate between December and August.

** Works submitted should show excellence in craft based media. Image quality should be superb.
