

Penland School of Craft Scholarship

CRITERIA:

- Open to all undergraduate junior and senior Art & Design majors.

SELECTION:

A selection committee appointed by the Chair of the Department of Art & Design will award scholarships. Selection will be based on the quality of the combination of submitted materials. Preference will be given to students actively pursuing an art education degree; however, serious consideration will be given to all deserving art students who meet the criteria. If the applicant pool is found to be unsatisfactory, the Penland Scholarship may be awarded to a graduate student.

DESCRIPTION:

Provides one full scholarship for a two-week summer session to an art student with an interest in teaching. Applicant should review Penland's current catalog of classes online at <https://penland.org/workshops/workshops-by-session/>, list 3 courses you are interested in taking, and ranked in order of preference. Students should not apply if they cannot attend the submitted list of classes.

REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION:

- Completed Penland Registration Form.
- Completed Art & Design Scholarship Application.
- Submit a 2-paragraph essay on why you want to take a class at Arrowmont this summer.
- A letter of support from your studio art advisor.
- 10 Digital artwork images.
- Unofficial transcript.
