DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIPSGENERAL INFORMATION

Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis. Students may apply, or reapply, to scholarships during the Spring semester for department scholarships and the Fall semester for Craft School Scholarships. Please use the [Scholarship Check List](#) on the website to determine your eligibility.

The scholarship term consists of the Fall and Spring semesters, one academic year. *Funds for department scholarships will be released in equal amounts (Fall & Spring) and applied towards tuition and fees.* Students who complete graduate requirements in a single semester will be awarded the full amount in the Fall. Beyond the application requirements, most scholarships do not have additional requirements during the scholarship term. Those listed below have the following stipulations:

- **Margaret Hays:** requires 6 ARTA/ARTH courses to be completed during the scholarship term (3 each semester)
- **Holly Adams:** requires full time enrollment, and 6 ARTA/ARTH courses to be completed during the scholarship term (3 each semester).

DEPARTMENT & CRAFT SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPSPORTFOLIO INFORMATION

To fulfill portfolio requirements, you must submit 10 digital files of artwork. Each file must only include one piece of artwork (no compilations of multiple works in one file). Submitted artwork can exist within the umbrella categories of 2D, 3D, and 4D art. *If you have submitted an application in a previous year, please note that you are expected to update your portfolio and application materials with current artwork and information.*

Accepted File Formats

- 2D & 3D artworks should be digitally photographed for submission. Photographs of artwork should be in focus and evenly lit. Image files should be saved as a JPEG at 300 DPI and approximately 4"x 6" in dimension.
- 4D (including video, performance, sound, and time-based) artworks should be digitally submitted using one of the following file formats: MP4, movie file, MP3, and AIFF. 4D artwork files should be edited to include clips no longer than 2 minutes. Select the section you think best represents the artwork.

File Naming Convention

Label artwork files using the following format: image number\_artist last name\_title of artwork. The number at the start of your file name should directly correspond with the information on your Artwork Identification list.

Example:

- 1\_LastName\_ArtworkTitle
- 2\_LastName\_ArtworkTitle
- 3\_LastName\_ArtworkTitle
