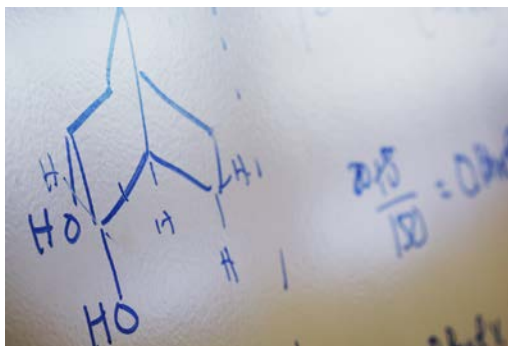


## VISITING SCIENTIST PROGRAM
