## Advanced Level Program Key Assessments

**Educational Leadership Disposition Assessment (EDLDA):** The <u>EDLDA</u> is a product of <u>Watermark</u> used to assess candidate dispositions throughout the Educational Leadership Program. Candidate dispositions are assessed in the first semester, at the midpoint or third semester, and in the final semester.

**Educator Disposition Assessment:** This proprietary assessment measures Reading and School Librarianship candidate dispositions at the beginning, mid-point, and end of the program.

**Praxis II:** The <u>Praxis II</u> assessments cover content knowledge that differs for each licensure area. Advanced program candidates must achieve qualifying scores prior to applying for licensure.

**Lesson Plan:** Lesson Plan development is an integral part of the educator preparation program. Reading Specialist Candidates submit their lesson plans in READ 5231 and READ 5241. Library Media Specialist candidates submit lesson plans in MEDA 5628, MEDA 5926, and MEDA 5929.

**TEAM**: The <u>Tennessee Educator Acceleration Model</u> (TEAM) is a comprehensive, student outcomes- based, statewide educator evaluation system used throughout districts in Tennessee that includes frequent observations and thorough feedback for educators. Field supervisors complete the TEAM on Reading Specialist candidates in READ 5231 and READ 5241, and the TEAM is completed on Library Media Specialist candidates in MEDA 5628, MEDA 5926, and MEDA 5929. School Librarianship candidates are presented a survey regarding TEAM scores.

**Completer Survey**: After being employed as a librarian for one-year and again after three-years of employment, alumni are asked to respond to a survey that asks them to evaluate their educator preparation experience related to their preparedness for their school librarian position.

**Principal/Employer Survey**: Principals/Employers of our graduates complete a survey one year after completers have left the program and become employed in their school/school district. Respondents evaluate the preparation of school librarians trained by ETSU.

**Candidate Demographic Data (CDD)**: CDD are collected across the candidate's progression through the program. These data include GPA and race/ethnicity.
