

BENCHMARKS FOR JOB-EMBEDDED LICENSURE



Benchmark #1: Admission to ETSU

- Complete application for admission/Obtain full admission status to ETSU Graduate School
- If you are a current ETSU
 Student skip to Benchmark #2

Benchmark #3: Coursewo<u>rk</u>

Meet with Advisor to review program of study regularly throughout program.

- Access provided Watermark account to submit course and program requirements
- Students must maintain continuous enrollment throughout the program and remain in academic good standing.

Benchmark #4: Additional Requirements

- University Supervisor Evaluation throughout program.
- Upload information and copy of an evaluation completed by the district each year as a Jobembedded student within Student Learning and Licensure.

Benchmark #2: Job-Embedded Licensure Package

- Submit an Intent to Hire letter that indicates the student has been or will be hired as the teacher of record by a school district in which ETSU holds a partnership.
- Complete the <u>Job-Embedded Application</u>.

Provide proof of content knowledge:

Bachelor's degree or higher in content area or passing <u>Praxis</u> II scores on all state required exams for licensure*. If applicable, passing scores should be sent both to TDOE and ETSU.

- Students seeking a math endorsement have the option of taking the NES exam.
- Complete Background Check Package
- Provide proof of Liability Insurance Coverage
- Students must maintain liability insurance throughout the job-embedded licensure process.

Benchmark #5: Program Completion

- Successful completion of all program requirements and any state required licensure exams.
- Apply for University graduation.
- Successful completion of at least 100 days of teaching experience as the teacher of record. All teaching experience must be uploaded into TN Compass.
