Please be advised: An add-on program does not necessarily meet the requirements of a minor, and substitutions or approvals made for teaching add-ons do not take the place of catalog requirements or departmental advisement for degree purposes.
- Courses counted toward an add-on must have a minimum grade of "C" (2.0) or equivalent unless otherwise stated in this program sheet.
- Add-ons will not be verified unless all requirements for initial Tennessee teaching license are met.
- Specialty area content assessments are required for add-on endorsements. Consult with your advisor for
  assessment information. When registering for the tests, be sure to designate East Tennessee State University,
  Recipient Code 1198, and Tennessee Dept. of Education, Recipient Code 8190, to receive a copy of your score
  report. NOTE: Tennessee requires a Social Security number on the score report to process educator
  certification paperwork.
- When coursework and assessments are complete, please contact the Certification Officer to request the college submit the endorsement recommendation to your account in TNCompass.
