- F. Updates from Shadow Team Dr. Currie informed the committee that the FBI will be on campus soon to monitor end points by setting up experimental hardware in the date center. They will monitor storage gateways to help with an added layer of security to research, watching for foreign and criminal infiltration. ETSU is a high volume target for its research and we are the 2<sup>nd</sup> university in the US to participate in this pilot program. The university gets approximately 10,000 phishing email per day, proving people are after our data.
  - Dr. Hagemeier spoke briefly about the IRB with Ballad and said they are working out details that may affect graduate students.

Shon Wheatley said GPSA will focus on getting grad students more involved on campus and they are working toward faculty/mentor relationships. He also told the group that the time and place for GPSA will be changing since Graduate School is in Yoakley and that he will have an update for the next meeting.7377

- Are the assignments/rigor appropriate for the credit hours requested?
- Are the learning outcomes appropriate for the level requested?
- Does this course add to the Mission and Vision of the ETSU?
- Does this course add to the Department?

# Step 4 – Make notes and contact the originator prior to the Curriculum Subcommittee Meeting

- This provides the originator with time to make corrections or further explain an area of concern.
- During the proposal presentation the originator can address these concerns and any changes can be made at that time.
