
JULY 2024 National Forum of State Nursing Workforce Centers 2024 Conference

From June 17 to 19, 2024, Dr. Monaco Briggs, representing our Center, participated in the National Forum of State Nursing Workforce Centers' 2024 Annual Conference. Themed "Accelerating Nursing Workforce Solutions: Innovative Programs and Data to Transform Policy," the conference tackled pressing issues related to the nursing workforce shortage. These included the K-12 pipeline, educational pathways, levels of RN and APRN education, workforce health and well-being, upskilling through academic and mentoring programs, workforce optimization, workforce data, and state and federal policies.

Dr. Briggs actively participated in 16 informative sessions, took advantage of numerous networking opportunities, and gathered essential resources to propel forward the Center's initiatives.

HRSA TN Workforce Data

In June, the Center released a comprehensive report based on HRSA data, comparing the nursing workforce from 2018 to 2022. This report offers detailed insights into demographic trends, educational achievements, licensure statuses, employment patterns, types of roles, work environments, and earnings specific to RNs, APRNs, and NPs. The analysis highlights significant changes in the nursing workforce dynamics over the past four years. Notably, while the number of RNs and non-APRN RNs has declined, there has been a simultaneous rise in APRNs and NPs. Advancing Nursing Podcast


