Engaged in Accreditation Process September 11 – 13, 2023

The Baccalaureate degree, Master's degree, Doctor of Nursing Practice degree, and Post-Graduate Advanced Practice Registered Nurse certificates offered by the College of Nursing at East Tennessee State University will be reviewed for continuing accreditation by a team of program evaluators from the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) September 11 - 13, 2023.

Comments will be shared with the program evaluators before the evaluation, but the comments will not be shared with the program during the review process. During the program review, the evaluation team considers signed third-party comments, if any, that relate to the accreditation standards.
