

| Undergraduate Policy on Repeated Courses |   |

## **Policy Purpose**

This policy specifies when an undergraduate student may repeat a course and how it affects the student's grade point average (GPA).

## **Policy Statement**

An undergraduate student may repeat a course in which the final grade is C+ or lower. The student may repeat a course in which they earned a grade of B- or higher only with the approval of the Provost or designee.

#### I. <u>GPA Calculations</u>.

ETSU uses repeated courses in calculating grade point averages and total credits attempted as follows:

- A. If a student repeats a course once, ETSU uses only the most recent attempt (excluding I, W, or WF grades) in calculating the GPAs.
- B. If a student repeats a course two or more times, ETSU uses all grades earned in the third and subsequent attempts in calculating GPAs.

All courses repeated count in credits attempted for GPA purposes. If a student repeats a course at another institution, the grade point averages are calculated in the same manner described above.

#### II. <u>Transcripts</u>.

All courses repeated appear on the academic transcript.
